A reminder that SATs begin next week, and our Year 6 pupils have continued to show fantastic commitment in their preparation. Their hard work, resilience and determination have been brilliant to see. The rest of the school has also shown understanding about what SATs week involves. Pupils know they can support their peers by keeping corridors and shared spaces quiet near the test rooms, and we really appreciate their kindness. We wish our year 6 pupils all the best next week.

Across the school, we are having a big focus on taking pride in our environment. Pupils are good at setting up and tidying away during lunchtime routines, and we are encouraging them to bring that same level of care to classrooms, corridors, breakout rooms and outdoor areas. In our recent community meeting, pupils shared an exciting idea: introducing a new reward system called Class Dojo. This online platform allows pupils to earn points for positive behaviour, effort, kindness and contributions around school. We will be trialing Class Dojo over the coming weeks and will update families once we have reviewed how it is working. It's wonderful to see pupils taking ownership of how they want success to be recognised.

Looking ahead, we will also be encouraging pupils to think about their future aspirations — who they want to become, what interests them, and the goals they may want to work towards as they grow. These conversations are always inspiring, and we look forward to supporting them.

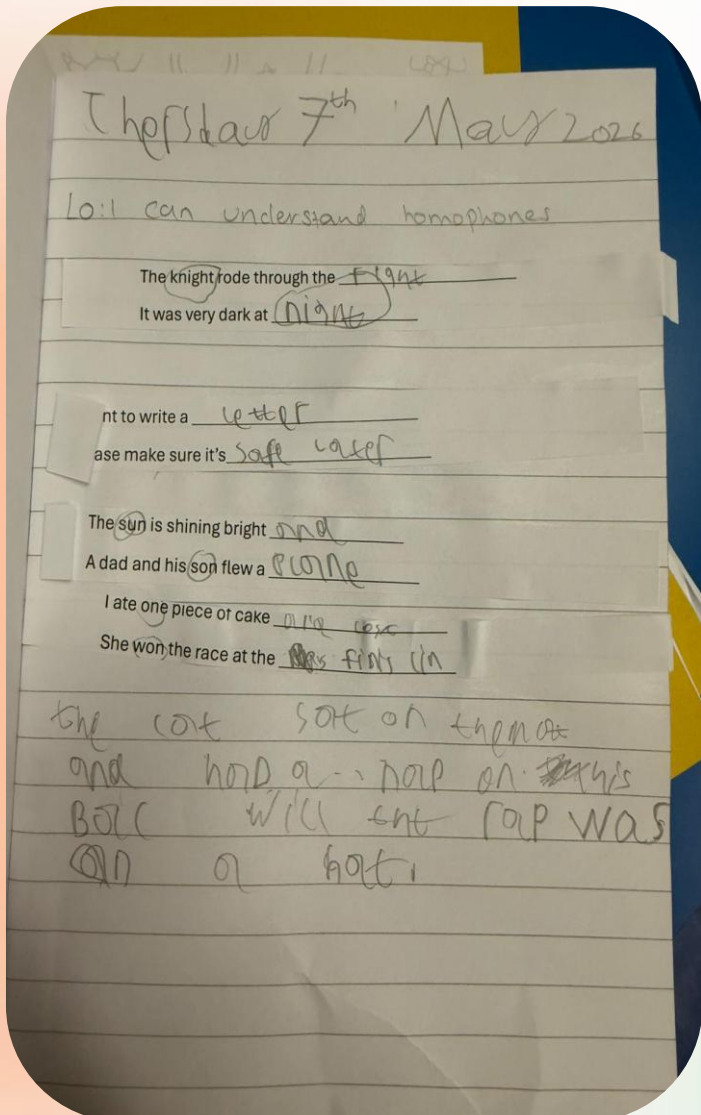
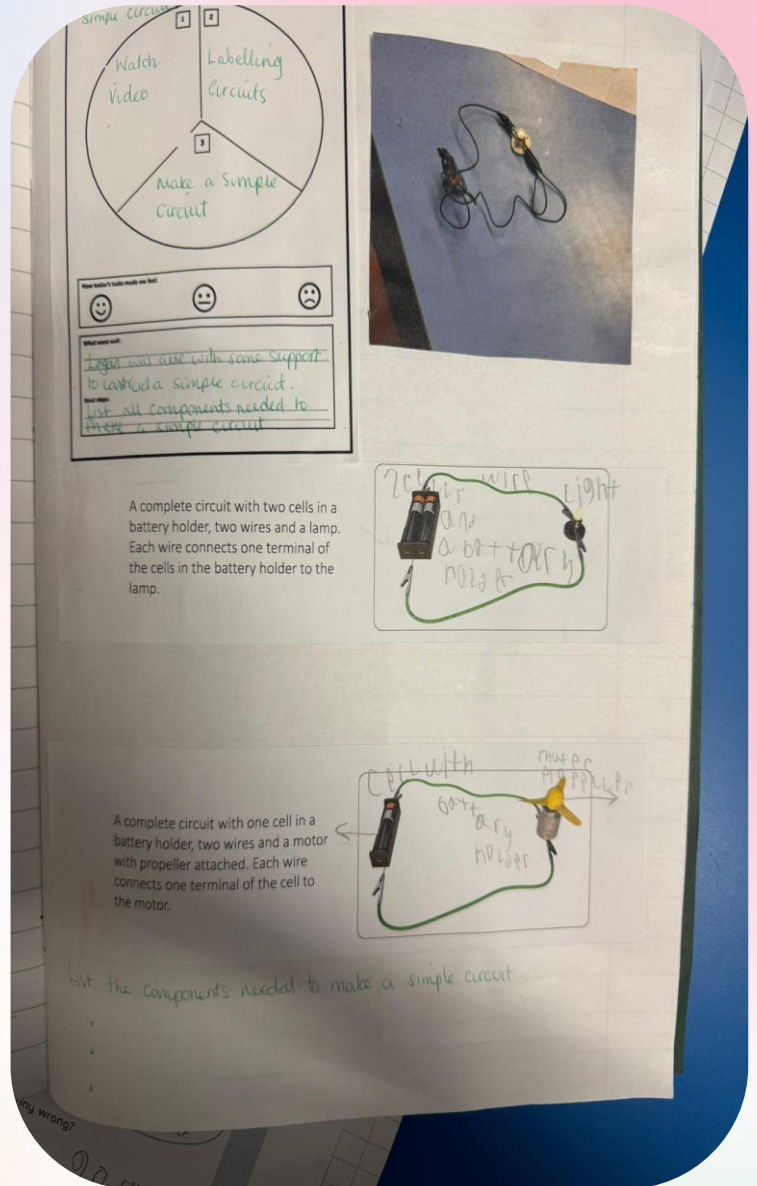
Neptune class was investigating and making observations on what plants need to grow- we tested cress seeds, when watering and not watering

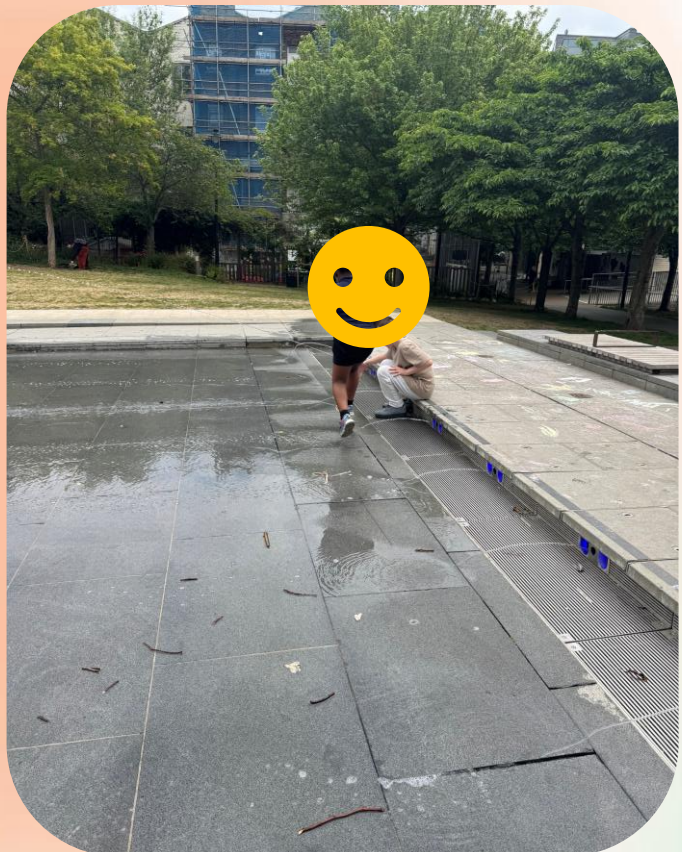
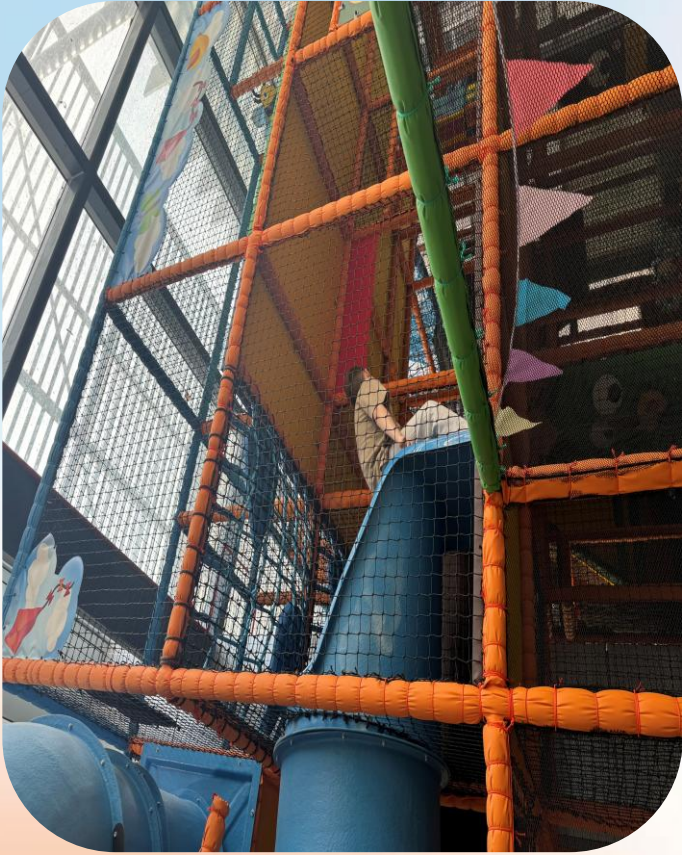
In Mars for science, we have been looking at circuits and what they need to help electricity pass.
