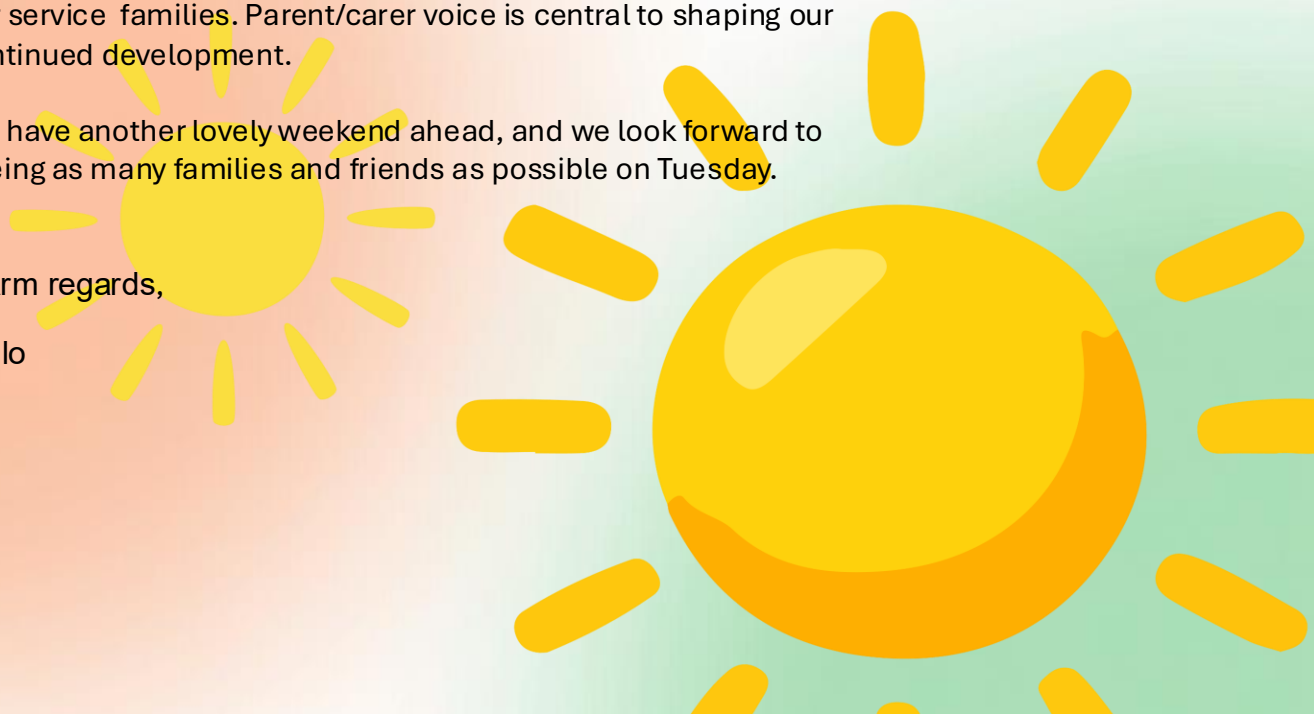
We have another lovely weekend ahead, and we look forward to seeing as many families and friends as possible on Tuesday.

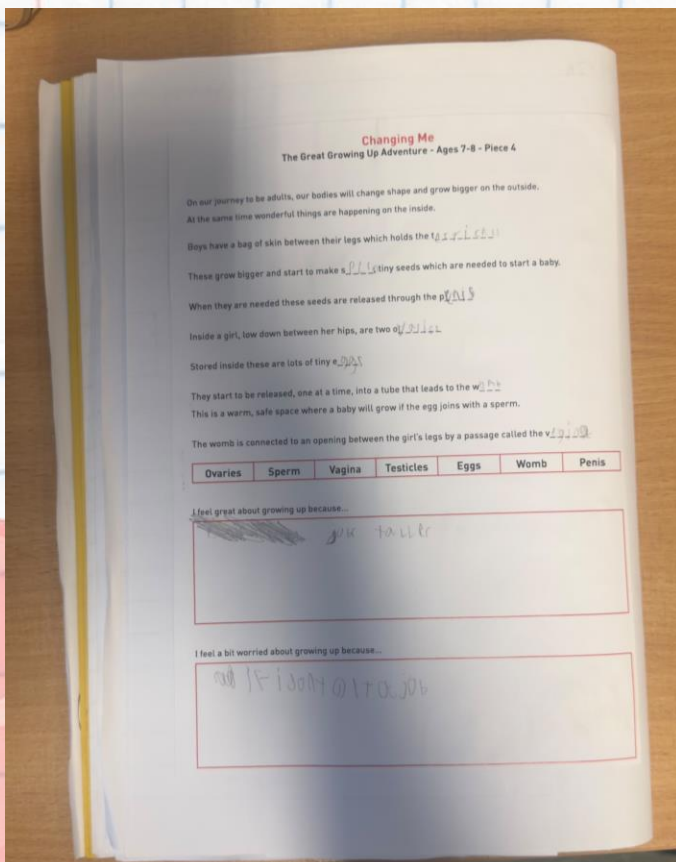
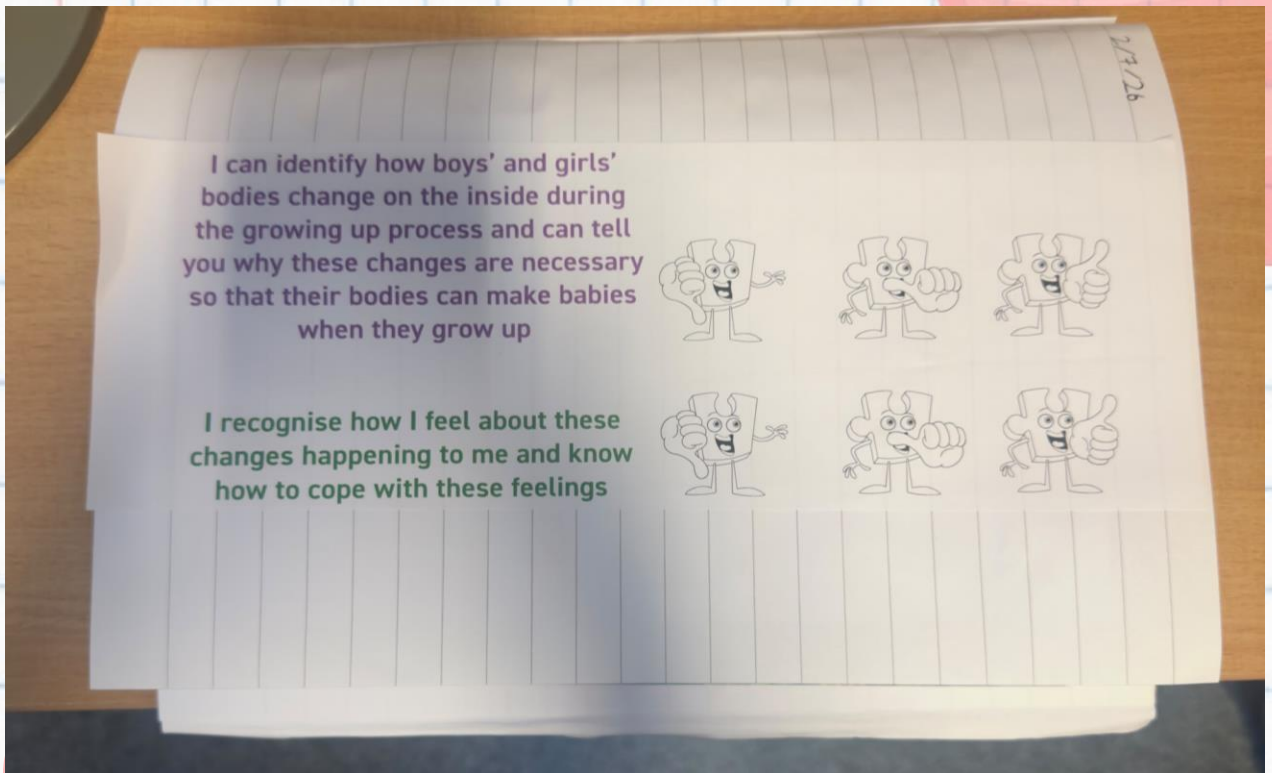

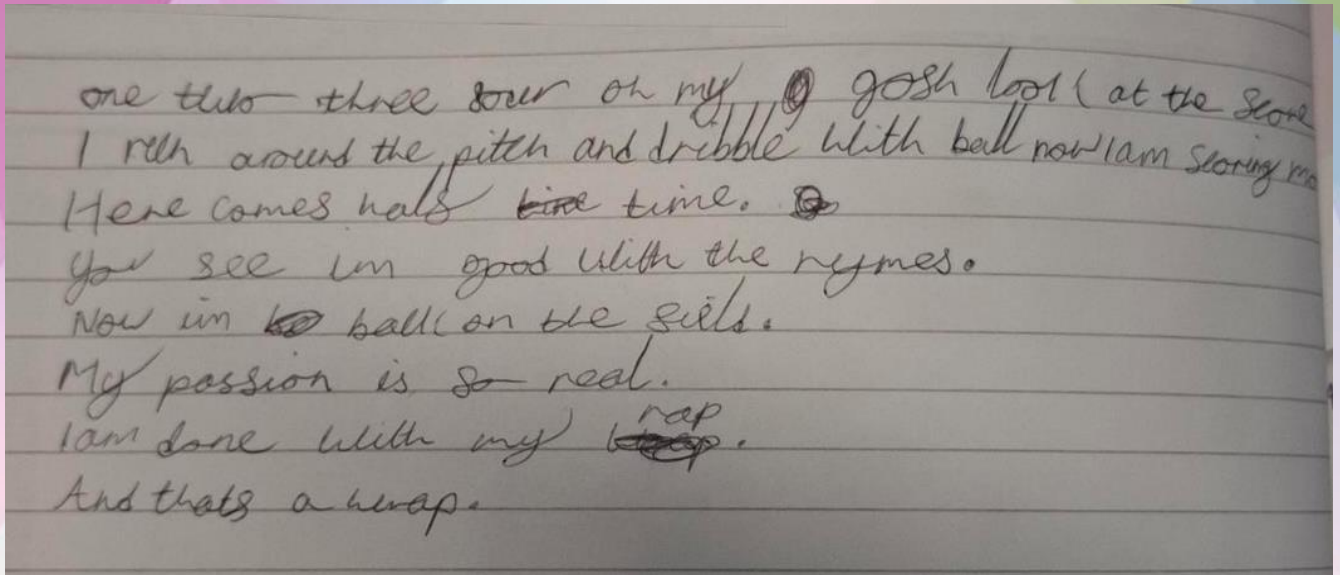
